Requirements:

Symbol 1 - Character at Beginning

Symbol 2: Character's Conflict

✓ Identify the main conflict your character faces. Identify and explain a symbol that represents this conflict faced by your character.

Symbol 3: Character at End

✓ Choose and explain a symbol that characterizes your character as they were at the end of the novel, after they have changed as a result of their conflict.

Symbol 4 - The Outsiders novel/theme

✓ Choose a symbol to represent the novel and its theme as a whole & explain
your reasoning.
